

RING ONE – Showjumping Classes to commence at 12 noon PROMPT

Annual Show Only – Classes to commence at 11.00am

Competitors in classes 1.3 - 1.10 who jump clear in the first round will go through to the jump off.

- 1.1 Lead Rein Jumping** raised poles, max height 30cms. Any suitable height horse/pony. Riders age 9 years and under and must be lead by an adult (16+). Riders who compete in the Lead Rein class may only jump in the Tiny Tots and Junior Beginners Showjumping, Lead Rein and Tiny Tot Working Hunter, and Beginners Working Hunter. One round only against the clock.
- 1.2 Tiny Tots Jumping** max height 40cm. Any suitable height horse/pony. Riders age 9 years and under. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed) but the adult must not assist unless the rider is in difficulty. Riders who compete in the Tiny Tot class may only jump in the Lead Rein and Junior Beginners Showjumping, Lead Rein and Tiny Tot Working Hunter, and Beginners Working Hunter. One round only against the clock.
- 1.3 Junior Beginners** max height of fences 45cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.4 Senior Beginners** max height of fences 55cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.5 Junior Pre-Novice** max height of fences 55cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.6 Senior Pre-Novice** max height of fences 70cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.7 Junior Novice** max height of fences 70cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.8 Senior Novice** max height of fences 85cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.9 Junior Open** max height of fences 85cms. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.10 Senior Open** max height of fences 1m. Any height horse/pony.
- 1.11 Clear Round** must be pre-entered. Competitors will be advised of the estimated start time. Will not take place at the Jubilee Willow Nook Show or Annual Show.

RING ONE – 4TH JUNE 2023 ONLY

GALA SHOWJUMPING

To commence on completion of the Showjumping classes and not before 1.30pm. Fence heights will be decided based upon entered competitors. Classes must be pre-entered and will only run if sufficient entries are received. £5 per class.

Class 1.12

- A. Speed – One round against the clock. Four seconds will be added for each fence knocked down or refused.
- B. Mixed Pairs – Both competitors begin in the start box. When the bell rings, one competitor begins and jumps the course and then returns to 'tag' the next competitor out of the box. Four seconds will be added for each fence knocked down or refused.
- C. Novelty Accumulator – Competitors have one minute to jump as many fences as they are able to, taking whichever line they like. Each fence is awarded a points total. Competitors may only jump each fence a maximum of three times. Fences must be jumped from the numbered side. After one minute the bell will ring. Competitors may then choose to jump the "joker fence" which will add to their points total if cleared, or be deducted from their points if not cleared.
- D. Horse and Hound – One round horse & rider and one round dog & handler. Four seconds will be added for each fence knocked down or refused.

RING ONE – 2ND JULY 2023 ONLY

GYMKHANA GAMES

To commence on completion of the Showjumping classes and not before 1.30pm. Classes must be pre-entered and will only run if sufficient entries are received.

Class 1.13

- A. Dog Agility / Jumping – One round against the clock.
- B. Walk, Trot, Canter, Lead – Competitors begin at the start line with the horse/pony. When the bell rings the competitors will walk one length, return in trot, canter one length, dismount and lead the horse/pony to the finish.
- C. Sack Race – Competitors race to pick up their sack and return to the finish inside their sack.
- D. Egg & Spoon Race – Competitors must complete two lengths of the ring with their egg and spoon, one mounted and one dismounted.

It is the responsibility of members who have won trophies to return them.

All trophies should be returned clean and engraved with the name of the class winner.

RING TWO – Working Hunter**Classes to commence at 10:30am****Clear Round – Entries at the ring - £5 per round****8.45 - 9.30am 45-55cms****9.30 -10.15am 65-75cms**

Competitors complete one round of jumping and, at the judge's discretion, will return to complete an individual show. Horses/ ponies may wear plain coloured boots for the jumping phase but they must be removed before entering the ring to complete the individual show.

Riders are reminded that practice fences should be jumped with the red marker to their right, and the white marker to their left. Riders are advised to wear an up to standard body protector whilst completing the jumping phase.

- In Working Hunter classes a pony must be 153cm and under and may be ridden by a member of any age.
- In Working Hunter classes a horse must exceed 153cm and may be ridden by a member of any age.

2.1 ★Lead Rein Working Hunter raised poles, max height 30cms. Any suitable height horse/pony (not exceeding 128cms for STARS qualification), riders age 9 years and under and must be lead by an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed). Riders who compete in the Lead Rein class may only jump in the Tiny Tot and Beginners Working Hunter, Lead Rein and Tiny Tot Showjumping and Junior Beginners Showjumping.

2.2 ★ Tiny Tot Working Hunter max height 40cm. Any suitable height horse/pony (not exceeding 128cms for STARS qualification), riders age 9 years and under. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed) but the adult must not assist unless the rider is in difficulty. Riders who compete in the Tiny Tot class may only jump in the Lead Rein and Beginners Working Hunter, Lead Rein and Tiny Tot Showjumping and Junior Beginners Showjumping.

2.3 Beginners Working Hunter Pony max height of fences 45cms. Open to plaited (including a running plait), hogged and M&M ponies.

2.4 Novice Working Hunter Pony max height of fences 60cms. Open to plaited (including a running plait), hogged and M&M ponies.

2.5 ★Open Working Hunter Pony open to plaited (including a running plait) or hogged ponies only. Ponies must jump in the correct height section.

To be run as one class. One set of rosettes will be presented and points will be awarded accordingly. Entries must be made in the correct section for the purpose of allocating qualifications.

- a) 133cms and under (max height of fences 65cms).
- b) Exceeding 133cms – 153cm (max height of fences 75cms).

2.6 Beginners Working Hunter Horse max height of fences 55cms. Open to plaited (including a running plait) or hogged horses.

2.7 ★Open Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony open to registered and non-registered M&M ponies. Ponies must jump in the correct height section.

To be run as one class. One set of rosettes will be presented and points will be awarded accordingly. Entries must be made in the correct section for the purpose of allocating qualifications.

- a) 133cms and under (max height of fences 60cms).
- b) Exceeding 133cms – 153cms (max height of fences 75cms).

2.8 Novice Working Hunter Horse max height of fences 75cms. Open to plaited (including a running plait) or hogged horses.

2.9 ★Open Working Hunter Horse max height of fences 90cms. Open to plaited (including a running plait) or hogged horses only.

To follow: Working Hunter Championship –Annual and Willow Nook Shows Only.

Members placed 1st or 2nd in classes 2.1 – 2.9 are eligible.

RING THREE – In Hand Classes to commence at 9:15am

- 3.1 ★Yearling & Youngstock** colt, filly or gelding born in 2020, 2021 & 2022.
- 3.2 ★Veteran** any height, age 15 and over.
- 3.3 ★Plaited Pony** 148cms and under.
- 3.4 Best Conditioned Pony** 148cms and under.
- 3.5 Part Bred** any age, any height, part bred of any breed.
- 3.6 ★Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds** open to registered and non-registered animals to include Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B.
- 3.7 ★Tiny Tots Handler** 7 years and under. **Hard hats with fastened chinstraps must be worn.** Handlers may be accompanied in the ring by an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed) but the adult must not assist in the handling of the pony unless the handler is in difficulty.
- 3.8 ★Young Handler** 8-11 years. **Hard hats with fastened chinstraps must be worn.**
- 3.9 ★Junior Handler** 12-17 years. **Hard hats with fastened chinstraps must be worn.**

Junior Best Rider – 16 years and under.

Senior Best Rider – 17 years and over.

Trophies will be presented to the competitors who receive the most nominations throughout the season from classes 5.1 – 5.15 inclusive.

The best rider, selected by the judge in each class at each show, will not necessarily be a placed competitor.

RING FOUR – Equitation and Ridden

Classes to commence at 09.00am

- 4.1 ★Best Turned Out** competitors must enter ridden (including lead rein). An individual show is not required.
- 4.2 ★Riding Club Horse** horses exceeding 148cms, rider any age. Will include one jump in individual performance (max height 80cms). Any suitable bridle can be used.
- 4.3 ★Riding Club Pony** ponies 148cms and under, rider any age. Will include one jump in individual performance (max height 60cm). Any suitable bridle can be used.
- 4.4 ★Senior Equitation** rider 18 years and over. Snaffle bridle only.
- 4.5 ★Junior Equitation** rider 12-17 years. Snaffle bridle only.
- 4.6 ★First Ridden Equitation** rider 11 years and under. Snaffle bridle only.
- 4.7 ★Lead Rein Equitation** rider 9 years and under. Open to any height horse or pony. Leader must be an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed). Snaffle bridle only and the lead rein must be attached to the noseband and be direct to the leader's hand. Rider not to compete in any other equitation class.

To follow: Equitation Championship –Annual and Willow Nook Shows Only.

Members placed 1st or 2nd in classes 4.2 – 4.7 are eligible.

LUNCH

Ring to recommence not before 12.30pm

Competitors entering these classes do not need to wear full showing attire but must be smartly dressed and wearing a long sleeved top, smart trousers/jodphurs, suitable footwear and a riding hat.

- 4.8 Beginners Showmanship** open to any rider who is novice, nervous or new to the show ring. Competitors may enter on the lead rein, with an adult walking (16+ and appropriately dressed) or by themselves. There will be no group go-round. Cantering optional in individual shows. The judge will offer showing tips and advice on your individual show. There will be no end of season points awarded for this class. **All competitors are expected to enter in the true spirit of this class (i.e. true beginners).**
- 4.9 Walk and Trot Class** walk and trot individual performance only. Competitors may enter on the lead rein. There will be no group go-round. **All competitors are expected to enter in the true spirit of this class.**
- 4.10 Novice/Nervous/New To The Ring** open to any rider and/or horse and pony who is novice, nervous or new to the show ring. Walk and trot only in group go-round. Cantering optional in individual shows. **All competitors are expected to enter in the true spirit of this class.**
- 4.11 Rider/Handler With A Disability** competitors may enter ridden (including lead rein) or in-hand. Competitors may be accompanied in the ring by an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed). There will be no group go-round.
- 4.12 Bonnie Pony** competitors may enter ridden (including lead rein) or in-hand.
- 4.13 Novelty** competitors may enter ridden (including lead rein) or in-hand.

5.1 Novice Ridden Pony not to exceed 148cms. Pony not to have won the overall points in this class in previous seasons, or to have won first place in any open showing class at Thornton Cleveleys & District Horse Club before 2023. Snaffle bridle only.

5.2 ★Lead Reinrider 9 years and under. Ponies must not exceed 128cms. Leader must be an adult (16+ and appropriately dressed). Snaffle bridle only and the lead rein must be attached to the noseband and be direct to the leader's hand.

To be run as one class. One set of rosettes will be presented and points will be awarded accordingly. Entries must be made in the correct section for the purpose of allocating qualifications.

a) Plaited

b) Mountain and Moorland

5.3 ★First Ridden rider 11 years and under. Ponies must not exceed 128cms. Snaffle bridle only. Cantering in individual performances only.

To be run as one class. One set of rosettes will be presented and points will be awarded accordingly. Entries must be made in the correct section for the purpose of allocating qualifications.

a) Plaited

5.4 ★Coloured open to Piebald and Skewbald only, any height.

5.5 ★Veteran any rider. Horse/pony 15 years and over. No spurs to be worn. No galloping in individual performances. Lead-rein competitors are eligible to enter.

5.6 ★M&M Large Breeds open to registered and non-registered animals to include Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. No spurs to be worn.

5.7 ★M&M Small Breeds open to registered and non-registered animals to include Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B. No spurs to be worn.

5.8 Novice Ridden Horse plaited or native. Horse exceeding 148cms. Horse not to have won the overall points in this class in previous seasons, or to have won first place in any open showing class at Thornton Cleveleys & District Horse Club before 2023. Snaffle bridle only.

5.9 Part Bred any age, any height, part bred of any breed.

5.10 ★Show Pony not exceeding 148cms.

5.11 ★Show Hunter Pony not exceeding 153cms.

5.12 ★Cob to include Show Cobs & Traditional Cobs. Any height.

5.13 ★Show Hunter Horse exceeding 153cms.

5.14 ★Show Horse to include all plaited show horses.

5.15 ★Race Horse to Riding Horse open to all registered RoR.
